Qualitas Medical Group Supports Conservation of the Great Apes

BUKIT MERAH, 19 AUGUST 2016- Earlier today, Qualitas Medical Group (Qualitas) handed over medical equipment in aid of the medical unit of the Bukit Merah Orang Utan Foundation.

According to Dr. Junaidi Ismail, the Associate Director of Business Development and Marketing, at Qualitas, Qualitas has already been participating in various social responsibility efforts. He said "We do have many CSR programmes and we are proud to extend this to the Orang Utan Community".

During his speech, Dr. Junaidi had commended YBhg. Tan Sri Datuk (Dr) Haji Mustapha Kamal for his efforts - in terms of energy and finances - in making the Orang Utan Island ex-situ project into a reality. Dr. Junaidi also said "As corporate body that operates in Malaysia, it is important to support the Orang Utan Island Foundation and help make it sustainable. This is important not only for future Malaysians, but also for people across the globe to visit the Orang Utans- the only great apes that are exclusive to this region."

Qualitas had handed over various medical equipment inclusive of a benchtop autoclave, a stainless steel incubator, sterile disposable inoculating tubes as well as a bacinerator in order to help equip the medical facility located on-site for infant Orang Utans.

"The Orang Utan Island, which was once known as Pulau Panjang was specifically chosen as the climate and vegetation on the island closely resembles that of Borneo and Sumatra, the native lands of the Orang Utans" said Dr. D. Sabapathy; CEO and Veterinary Surgeon at the Bukit Merah Orang Utan Island Foundation.

The facility was first opened to the public in February 2000, and visitors could view the animals ranging about in the initial open exhibit from a viewing platform located about 10 meters from the island lakeside. By 31 August 2001, a secure tunnel within the open exhibit was constructed and opened to the public where human visitors find themselves within the fenced enclosure while the orangutans ranged freely.

Moving forward, the foundation hopes that the Orang Utan Island will not only continue to help deliver conservation education and awareness to schoolchildren, school teachers, colleges, universities and the public; but also help facilitate scientific ex-situ research on the Bornean Orang Utan.

In addition to that, they also hope to help deliver practical knowledge and skills to undergraduates from the relevant majors in in-situ and ex-situ conservation and management of the Bornean Orang Utan; while training, developing and enhancing the capacity of not only rehabilitation and zoo staff, but also students and practitioners of veterinary medicine in the diagnosis, treatment and care management of the Orang Utan.
